



Servicing of the FourStar Golf Cruiser

Recommended Products for the FourStar Golf Cruiser

In order to get the most out of your FourStar Golf Cruiser, regular maintenance is required. We recommend the following products are used as part of a regular maintenance schedule.

Chain maintenance:

Adhesive lubricant or a chain oil is best used to maintain lubrication and water resistance of the chain. This will reduce the wear of the chain and sprockets along with preventing rusting.

Recommended interval: After every use



De-grease of the chain should also be done also to remove any large build-up of deposits and dirt.

Recommended interval: 3-4 months



Brakes:

Brake level fluid should be checked regularly, use the inspection window on the brake master cylinder to check the level. The level should not drop below the bottom third of the window. If it is below this, clean around the cap of the master cylinder, undo the two screws and remove the cap. Avoid getting any dirt or contaminants on any of the parts. Fill up with brake fluid, DOT 3 or DOT 4 type brake fluid only from a sealed container. Clean up any spilt fluid immediately to avoid damage to the paintwork.

Recommended interval: As required



Gearbox:

Keeping lubricant in the gearbox is essential to smooth operation and longevity of your vehicle. Remove the brass nipple on the top of the motor and inspect the gears. They should have a fine coating of oil on them. If not, add 60-80ml of gearbox or differential oil, rotate the gears and check again. Top up by 20ml amounts until oil is visible on the gears. **DO NOT ADD GREASE**, grease will only provide small amounts of lubrication and can damage the gearbox seals.

Recommended interval: Check every 6 months.



General lubrication:

Spray a general purpose lubricant on all moving surfaces such as steering joints, wheel bearings and all other moving parts. This helps to keep them freely moving and free of dirt and grease build up.

Recommended interval: every 3-4 months.



Cleaning:

Cleaning of your FourStar Golf Cruiser will keep the paint and body work in good condition and looking great out on the course. Use any type of automotive cleaner or a good quality plastic cleaner. Avoid using water, harsh chemicals such as solvents, always use a soft cloth or microfiber towel. This will prevent damage to the body and electrical systems.

Recommended interval: As required.
